The May meeting featured speaker is CAG member Marion Mason. The following is background information about Marion. We look forward to his presentation!

I am a visual artist who taught high school art for 42 years.

I earned the Bachelor of Arts Degree in studio art (sculpture concentration) from the University of South Carolina, and the Master of Fine Arts Degree (in sculpture) from the University of Georgia. In addition, I earned the Master of Education (adult and community education) from Carolina.

Prior to my teaching career, I served as an officer in the U.S. Navy for nine years (five on active duty), and am a veteran of the Vietnam War.

I began my 42-year art teaching career as the artist-in-residence and on-site coordinator at the former Richland District One Artistically Talented and Gifted (ARTAG) High School Program. Many years ago, I was a member of the design and implementation team of the original Tri-District Arts Consortium (Tri-DAC) and I taught sculpture there for fifteen summers. Also, I had the privilege of teaching three summers in the three-week Honors Program at the SC Governor's School for the Arts and Humanities. I have conducted many art workshops for school, district, community, and state-wide groups, from middle schoolers through adults. In 1982 I was awarded Teacher of the Year recognition at C. A. Johnson High School, and was also honored as the Richland District One Teacher of the Year.

Since retiring from teaching in January 2019, I am now a full-time professional artist again, and exhibit and sell my sculpture, pendants, and earrings. Over the years I have shown and won awards at many local, state, regional, and national competitive and invitational exhibits.

Cayce Arts Guild is a nonprofit organization incorporated by the SC Secretary of State and designated IRS 501c3 tax exempt organization.
