## <u>Landsford Canal State Park, 2051 Park Drive, Catawba, SC 29704</u> Thursday, May 27, 2021 (tentative)

Check the web site for park rules and other info. Admission is \$3.75/S.C. senior It's a fairly flat walk but would require careful stepping.

Stretched along the Catawba River on the South Carolina fall line, Landsford Canal State Park is home to the well-preserved remains of the canal system that made the river commercially navigable from 1820 to 1835. The Catawba River is home to the largest known stand of the rocky shoals spider lily, a flower species found predominantly in the Southeast. Peak bloom season for the rocky shoals spider lily is during May and June. It's about an hour and a half from Cayce. We can make more precise plans as the time nears and date finally determined. It's a bit tricky to be there when the lilies are blooming. We plan to have lunch at the fish camp nearby.
